What is EduSport?

EduSport is a **youth empowerment** organization that provides education and sport to those **who need it most**.

We *empower communities to uplift*themselves by creating social-impact jobs
for local unemployed youth to work in
local schools.



The Challenge

South Africa stats:

- 81% of grade 4 learners can't read for meaning
- RSA has the 4th highest youth unemployment rate in the world
- 95% of public schools do not have access to rugby, cricket or hockey facilities or coaching







The Solution

EduSport has developed a 5-pronged holistic model to:

- 1. Fight youth unemployment
- 2. Provide literacy and numeracy support
- 3. Develop and improve access to sports
- 4. Assist with psychosocial well-being
- 5. Improve quality of life



The Box

Coach in the Box (CIAB) is a mobile, cost-effective solution that can be scaled to drive major change and positive impact in underserved communities in South Africa.





Our Service

The CIAB Strategy is to provide a holistic youth-empowerment intervention to primary school learners in underserved communities.

We offer

- Sport (Rugby, Netball)
- Education (Literacy, Numeracy)
- Empowerment (Psychosocial coaching)







Employment

We believe in *empowering the community to uplift itself* by providing local jobs in local schools.

Youth Coaches are identified, screened, trained, and contracted to transfer the various skills within their own communities.



The Tools

The box is issued to each coach and contains equipment, training manuals, tools, and resources required for successful programme implementation. Through various stakeholders and strategic partnerships, CIAB enables coaches with what they need to thrive.

Cost of a Box?

Cost Breakdown:

- □ Contents and training R5 000
- □ Coach annual stipend R24 000 / R48 000

The monthly stipend for Empowerment CIAB differs as we employ qualified Social Workers as coaches for this box

Option 1: Once-off payment

Pay upfront for the cost and contents of the box and the annual stipend of the coach

Option 2: Instalment payment

Pay upfront for the cost and contents of the box and pay the annual stipend of the coach over 12 months

Option 3: Box Contents & Training payment

Should workplace funding be obtained only the box, contents, and coach training costs are required



The 5-pronged Solution














Partnered with Skills Builder

Edusport has partnered with Izibalo to improve math literacy in the Foundation Phase. Izibalo, meaning "mathematics or counting" in the isiXhosa language, is a Non-Profit Company that provides learner-centered maths tuition to learners in rural and township areas in South Africa.

Izibalo's vision is to increase the number of learners who write the final pure maths exam in Grade 12 in the rural and township areas of South Africa. To achieve this they have partnered with CIAB and put a program together to improve Math literacy for learners in the Foundation Phase.

Edusport has partnered with Thetha Nathi to envisage a resilient community with a deeper understanding of self by providing psychosocial support resulting in a society with an enhanced positive self-image.

The Primary Objectives of the Organization are to:

- Provide counselling and support to learners in schools to alleviate the long-term effects of trauma.
- Empower learners with long-term coping skills so that they are better equipped to deal with future stressors.
- Provide community-based services by placing social workers directly in schools within our rural communities.
